5 solid colored, 70 page, wide ruled spiral notebooks (1 will be cut in half: $\frac{1}{2}$ for morning work and $\frac{1}{2}$ for math wake up work, other four are for: Math notes, science notes, history notes, music.)

2 solid colored, 200 page, spiral notebooks (1 for Riggs homework: Riggs sheets and word studies, 1 for Writing: writing, grammar and Homer copybook)

1 box of red pens (at least 4 pens: not red pencils)

1 box of #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) Students should have a large supply of pencils to last them all year. Each child should have at least 4 sharpened pencils in their pencil bag each day. Keep the rest at home to avoid clutter within the desks.

2 pens (black or blue)

1 small pencil sharpener with a shell to keep at student's desk

1 pencil bag

1 clip board

8 packages of wide ruled loose leaf paper (1 package= 180 pages: 2 packages will be brought per quarter)

2 packages of lined index cards (1 at the beginning of semester 1 and second at beginning of semester 2)
